Korean Air To Launch Nonstop Flights Between LAX and Sao Paulo, Brazil

The only non-stop air service between Sao Paulo, Brazil and Los Angeles International Airport will commence at 7:30 this evening as Korean Air launches its thrice weekly, three-class flights. The airline is operating Monday, Wednesday and Friday flights from LAX to São Paulo (GRU) using Boeing 777-200 aircraft outfitted with lie-flat sleeper seats in premium classes and on-demand movies and music throughout the aircraft. The flights depart LAX at 7:30 p.m. and arrive in São Paulo at 11:00 a.m. the next morning. The return flight on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays, leaves São Paulo at 1:30 p.m. and arrives at LAX at 9:30 p.m. the same day.

"Korean Air's non-stop flight between LAX and São Paulo is a key route for people who want to conduct business in South America's largest city," says John Jackson, Korean Air's director of sales and marketing for the Americas. "Korean Air already offers the best options
